The May 28th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 26 members present. Lloyd read a thank-you card from Harold. Willie is now home from the hospital.

Minutes: The minutes of our April meeting were read. Moved by Marilyn, seconded by Steve, “The minutes are approved as presented.” Carried

Treasurer’s Report: Villa presented the Treasurer’s report. Moved by Villa, seconded by Eugene, “The Treasurer’s report be approved as presented.” Carried

Business Arising:

1. Spring Rally: The Spring Rally will be scheduled for Saturday, June 13th, starting from Ellis Bridge. The registration area has been confirmed with required space and utilities. Garry indicated he would make an outdoor fire pot for a prize. Prizes will be \$10-25, geo-cache prizes \$5-10 with a 50/50 draw. Curtis indicated he would speak with Dave’s Sports Center, Extreme Torque – BRP, and Power Sports inquiring if they will donate prizes for the Rally. Lloyd distributed the posters. Other promotion will include the websites of Skedaddle Ridge and the NBATVF, local Clubs Facebook and Twitter.

2. Club Draw: Kayla has the form for the firewood draw and will speak with Bob regarding tickets.

3. Trail Map: The Club is awaiting the final version of the Skedaddle Ridge map from the Provincial Trails Manager. A computer software program is required to complete this map. Moved by Eugene, seconded by Doug, “Skedaddle Ridge purchase the required software for this purpose.” Carried

New Business:

1. Trail Maintenance / Bridge Repair: The required planks for Big Teaque Bridge are located at Alex’s. The trail near the Culberson Rest Area requires fixing, including a two foot culvert. Kevin will pick up the culvert. Alex will manage the installation of two culverts near the Currie Road. It was noted the Snowmobile and ATV Clubs should be communicating and working closely on trail maintenance, including signage. Funds are provided to both organizations from the Trail Infrastructure Fund to support trail maintenance, particularly those related to safety. It was referenced some staff from the Dept. of Natural Resources are now with the Dept. of Public Safety and will be more actively involved with enforcement.

2. NBATVF Board Meeting: Due to accommodation concerns, the NBATVF will not be holding their June meeting in the Skedaddle Ridge area.
