### **Old Business:**

1. Kenneth Rest Area: The toilet, due to ongoing vandalism has been removed from this rest area.
2. Trail Maintenance: The Wasson Rest area has had new lumber installed and painted.
3. Trail Signage: The former Provincial #10 signs have the NEW Provincial trail #25 decals installed. Moved by Bob, seconded by Allison, “We order 200, # 25 decals at a cost of approximately \$1 each from possibly Auto Majik in Grand Falls.” Carried.

### **New Business:**

1. Theme Trails: The NB Dept., of Tourism is promoting ‘Themed Trails’ and requesting Quad Clubs identify these on their maps. Trails would be of varied distances, include tourist attractions, be properly identified and a description provided for each themed trail for outdoor enthusiasts.
2. GPS Trail: The Club was requested to provide the name of a member(s) who could accompany the Provincial Dept. of Natural Resources and Energy Development Trail team mapping Quad trails. Alex agreed to provide assistance when contacted.
3. Rabbit Road: It was recommended a Permit be applied for this decommissioned road. This may be a project for 2021, if approved.
4. Rest Area Repairs: Eugene indicated he was prepared to check the various rest areas and undertake necessary repairs.
5. Region 7 Meeting: The meeting will be held in Woodstock, Wed. Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>. Allison and Alex will attend on behalf of Skedaddle Ridge.
6. Trail Permits: These will be forwarded to Quad NB and 2021 permits will be available Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>.
