Minutes: February 2019

The February 28th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 18 members present. A moment of silence was held in memory of Beverly Prosser.

Minutes: The minutes of the January meeting were read. Moved by Stirling, seconded by Kathy, "The January minutes are approved as presented." Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Allison presented the Treasurer's report. Moved by Allison, seconded by Jim, "The treasurer's report is accepted as presented." Carried.

Old Business:

1. **Trail Maintenance / Culvert:** Allison mentioned Charles Lindsay will commence work on the connecting trail when the trail is dryer. Allison referenced the culvert pipe will be approximately \$2600 and will present more information at the next meeting.
2. **Website:** It was referenced there were some concerns identified with the Skedaddle website. Bob will investigate and rectify.
3. **Cards / Maps:** Bob ordered 50 cards and 500 updated maps and these will be picked up upon completion and delivered to various locations.
4. **Long Lake Adventurers:** Kevin updated the members on the initiative. The proposed dates for the ATV trip would be Sept. 16th and 17th. The cost is \$175 per person inclusive. It was suggested that the River Valley ATV Club be apprised on this trip. Bob will contact this Club.

New Business:

1. **Five Year Plan:** A template was presented to the Club that could be used to assist in the preparation of a five year plan on proposed trail maintenance and development. The NBATVF was requesting input from the Clubs to assist in the preparation of a financial request to the Provincial government. It was suggested a Club Directors' meeting be held to start this process. It was noted the NBATVF and Irving's have an Agreement for trail use and access.
2. **Annual General Meeting:** The meeting will be April 13-14, 2019 in the Miramichi. Allison and Kelly will be the Club representatives.
3. **Trail Maintenance:** Allison will contact Charles Lindsay regarding the installation of a used flat-bed trailer on the East Knowlesville Road to address a bridge concern.
4. **Grafton-Rail Bridge Initiative:** Bob gave an updated report on this project. The Committee is awaiting feedback on financial support and to date, there has been limited communication from both the MP and MLA on this project.
