Minutes: July 2018

The July 26th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 16 members with one guest, Stewart Manual attending.

Pres. Curtis opened the meeting and a moment of silence was held in memory of Norma Reed.

Minutes: The minutes of the June meeting were read by Stirling. Moved by Stirling seconded by Jim, "The June minutes are approved as presented." Carried

Treasurer's Report: Allison presented the Treasurer's report. He reviewed the income and expenses for the month of June. Some discussion was held on the Trust Fund account and how amount deposited is determined. Moved by Allison, seconded by Dalton, "The treasurer's report is accepted as presented." Carried.

Old Business:

1. Barrie's Bridge: Completed with exception of some grading.

New Business:

2. Trail Inspection: Curtis, Allison and Alex toured some of the trails with Acadia Timber and discussed issues. They reported this to be an excellent tour.
3. Hartland Parade: Some suggested participation in the Sat. Aug. 4th Hartland Parade. If interested, members should arrive at the Hartland Community School by 10:00 AM.
4. Corn Boil: The date is Sun. Aug. 26th at 2:00 PM with a pot-luck. Club supplies corn and hot-dogs.
5. Bridge Repairs: It was noted the bridge on the Clearwater behind Juniper requires some attention. The Snowmobile Club responsible in that area will be contacted as this is a shared trail and financial support for this maintenance will be requested.
6. Woodstock-Grafton Bridge Initiative: Bob gave an update on the progress of this initiative. The project is moving forward and a request for funding has been started.
