Minutes: July 2019

The July 25th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 10 members present. A moment of silence was held for Madeline Paget and Roydon Crabb.

Minutes: The minutes of the June meeting were read by Bob. Moved by Bob seconded by Alex, “The June minutes are approved as presented.” Carried

Treasurer’s Report: Allison presented the Treasurer’s report. Moved by Allison, seconded by Marilyn, “The treasurer’s report be accepted as presented.” Carried. It was noted some Trust Fund monies had been received from the Federation to support trail maintenance repairs.

Old Business:

1. Trail Maintenance: Howard Brook and Nashwaak Bridge repairs are currently being undertaken and will be completed in the near future.
2. Number 10 Provincial Trail Signs: Work continues in placing the signs.
3. Night Run: Positive feedback has been received on the Night Run that occurred July 13th. Members recommended in 2020 this event should once again be conducted.
4. Trail Map: The Club has received is awaiting feedback on when the Dept. of Energy and Resource Development will be mapping the Club trails as part of the Provincial map.
5. Trail Signs: Allison and Bob will arrange to have generic signs made that will be placed on the trails to remind users they are on a Skedaddle Club maintained trail.
6. Trail: The rail bed from Newburg Junction to Perth is not an approved trail, thus no ATV’s are permitted. Members are being asked regularly about the use of that rail bed.

New Business:

1. Membership: It was noted to date there are 172 members in the Club.
2. Summer Picnic: Members decided to prepare posters for this event at Mount Pleasant Community Hall on Aug. 31st. The poster will be posted onto the Club website. Allison and Bob were asked to prepare this poster.
3. Fall Rally: The date is Sat. Oct. 5th starting at Sugar Moon. Posters will be prepared and a copy posted onto the Club website. Bob will prepare this poster.
4. Trail Work Day: August 10th, meet at Ellis Bridge 9:00 AM.
5. Report: Bob updated the members on some initiatives the NBATVF is currently engaged. (ie: marketing, by-law amendments, promotion, map). He asked members if they have questions or concerns to contact him. The Region 7 meeting will be held at the Woodstock Masonic Lodge, Thurs. October 10th
