Minutes: June 2018

The June 28th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 16 members present. It was noted a cheque in the amount of \$90 had been received in memory of Gerald Prosser.

Minutes: The minutes of the May meeting were read by Bob. Moved by Bob seconded by Eugene, "The May minutes are approved as presented." Carried

Treasurer's Report: Allison presented the Treasurer's report. He reviewed the income and expenses for the Spring Rally, map donation and material expenses for trail maintenance Moved by Allison, seconded by Alex, "The treasurer's report is accepted as presented." Carried.

Old Business:

1. Spring Rally: A discussion was held and no problems occurred. Positive feedback received.

3. Sister's Bridge: A WAWA permit is being processed and upon receipt, a new deck will be installed.
4. Fall Rally: It was noted the Fall Rally will start from Sugar Moon. Date: October 6th

New Business:

1. Membership: It was noted the Club has 399 members and more registrations have been completed.
2. Night Run: Curtis reported the date will be Sat. July 21st starting at 7:00 PM from Ellis Bridge. Participants can bring their own snack. A free lunch for Club members at the Craig Rest Area.
3. Woodstock-Grafton Bridge Initiative: Bob gave an overview on the project. The Town of Woodstock forwarded a letter of support for ATV's to cross their property and for this project to the local volunteer committee working on this project. All land owners on the 7.2 kms. of rail bed that passes through the Town of Woodstock to Rte. 104 have approved ATV access. Receiving this support is a requirement for funding to replace the span and repair the former CP Rail bridge that crosses the St. John River. Bob provided some highlights of ATV activities and projects within the region (ie: Economic Study, Signature Trail, Action Plan, Events of other Clubs and trail approval's received). He indicated some areas have expressed concern about ATV use on illegal trails and that some have requested more emphasis on law enforcement visibility.

Night ATV Run... Sat. July 21st . If inclement weather the Run will be held July 28th. This event replaces the Fun Run.

Corn Boil ... no date has been established, further discussion on this at a future meeting.
