Old Business:

1. Trail Maintenance: South Knowlesville Road bridge work is still scheduled to start in July. The trailer is stored at Curtis residence and a person has expressed interest in the trailer wheels.
2. Number 10 Provincial Trail Signs: It is planned to have all signs erected this summer.
3. Sister's Bridge: The bridge abutments are in place and work continues on this project.
4. Trail Map: The Club is waiting to hear from the NBATVF when commencement will begin to map the entire trail system to meet standards for a Provincial map.
5. Safety Course: It was noted the recently held ATV Safety Course held in Woodstock for the area was successful.

New Business:

1. Membership: It was noted to date there are 172 members in the Club.
2. Trail: The rail bed from Newburg to Perth is not an approved trail, thus no ATV's are permitted. Members are being asked regularly about the use of that rail bed.
3. Signs: It was noted during the Rally some signs were down and posts need to be replaced.
4. **Night Run: The Club plans to conduct an ATV Night Run on Sat. July 13th starting from Ellis Bridge, 7:00 PM. Route will be approximately 50 kms. Hot dogs, sausages, soft drinks will be provided by the Club. Bring your night camera.**
