### **Minutes: May 2019**

#### **Old Business:**

1. **Safety Course:** Date is Sat. June 15<sup>th</sup>. Ken Legge, NBATF, will be the instructor. The Course is being offered in Woodstock, across from the High School in the grandstand parking lot starting at 8:30 AM. It is recommended youth participate in the program prior to applying for Club membership.
2. **Spring Rally:** There will be a BBQ offered during the Rally. Arrangements have been completed for the registration area, signage, prizes, trailer delivery, etc. Some of the Ge-caches are missing and must be replaced. The website geo-cache locations should be updated.
3. **Trail Maintenance:** Rabbit Road bridge work will commence in July, Ellis Bridge work is in progress, Sister's Bridge decking is being prepared and the grading and ditching is underway. A WAWA Permit is being processed to complete this project. Trees must be removed from the trail near Barrie's Bridge. The work day has been postponed to June 20<sup>th</sup> and will start at Chapmanville. A date to complete this work will be decided later if not completed in one day.
4. **Long Lake Adventurers:** Plans for this excursion have not been completed.
5. **Flat Bed Trailer:** The trailer is located at Curtis's place and it requires 10' x 3" lumber for the roof. This will be ordered for the trailer.
6. **Trail Infrastructure Fund:** Funds are available and the Club was encouraged to apply early, in particular for work on the Provincial #10 trail. .

1. **Regional and Acadia Timber Meeting:** A report will be provided at the next meeting.
