Minutes: September 2018

The Sept. 27th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 17 members present.

Minutes: The minutes of the August meeting were read by Stirling. Moved by Stirling seconded by Doug, "The August minutes are approved as presented." Carried.

Treasurer's Report: Allison presented the Treasurer's report. Moved by Allison, seconded by Eugene, "The treasurer's report is accepted as presented." Carried.

Old Business:

1. South Sister's Bridge: This bridge has not been repaired as the Club has not been able to find a person to conduct the required repairs.

3. Connecting Club Trail: Members were updated on the cost and repairs conducted on the connecting trail. Additional work will be performed in 2019.

5. Trail Damage: It was noted many trees have been cleared from the trails. A thank-you was expressed to the volunteer members who performed this clearing.
6. Fall Rally: Sat. Oct. 6th Start location: Sugar Moon, Divide. A BBQ provided on the trail. Willie, Stirling, Kelly, Marilyn, Alex are organizing the Fall Rally and posting signage for the 85 km. route.

New Business:

1. Falls Brook Center: A letter was received and will be discussed at a future meeting.
2. Trail Signage: A discussion was held regarding possible signage to inform the public of the work done by the Club. It has been noted many do not understand the work done by volunteers and the source of the funds to maintain safe trails. This will be discussed at a future meeting.
3. Regional Meeting: Allison and Alex updated the members on the regional meeting. Topics of Liability, Trail Permits, Equipment Fund, Trail Infrastructure Fund, 2019 Jamboree hosted by Nashwaak Valley ATV Club, Millville Mud-Runner acquisition of a trail dust control trailer were some of the topics reviewed. Adam Russell and Robert Stokes were elected or re-appointed as regional directors. There was a discussion on establishment of an emergency fund to address respective Club needs. It was recommended at the meeting this topic be presented to the Board of Directors of the NBATVF.
