

Skedaddle Ridge Trails People Inc.

Minutes: September 28, 2017

The September 28th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center with 15 members present. Curtis called the meeting to order at 7:08 PM. .

Minutes: The minutes of the August meeting were read by Stirling. Moved by Stirling seconded by Kelly, "The August minutes are approved as presented." Carried

Treasurer's Report: Villa presented the Treasurer's report. Moved by Villa, seconded by Willie, "The treasurer's report is accepted as presented." Carried.

Old Business:

1. **Christmas Social:** Following discussion, moved by Willie, "The Christmas Social to begin at 4:00 PM." Seconded by Kelly. Carried
2. **Connecting Trail:** It was reported the connecting trail between Skedaddle and Millville Clubs was approved on Tuesday of this week. It was noted the Club Application had been approved earlier, pending approval of another Committee as it was discovered part of the proposed inter-linking trail passed through a PNA area (Protected Natural Area). This Committee met and it was noted the trail would not be of concern to this area.
3. **Trail Map:** Bob amended the current map and submitted to the printer. It was decided an initial printing of 250 maps would be made and these would be available for the Fall Rally and at locations selling the 2018 Trail Permits effective October 1st. It was announced that eight businesses supported the cost of printing the maps with a donation of \$50 to have their business logo printed on the maps and promoted in social media.
4. **Lotto Tickets:** Members were reminded to return their sold tickets to Kayla.
5. **Trail Infrastructure Fund:** It was noted the Application for funding the trail equipment maintenance trailer received approval for 50% of the amount requested. The dollar amount of requests from the Provincial Clubs exceeded the Fund allotment with many applications not receiving approval. This trailer will be stored inside the Club trailer for the winter.
6. **Fall Rally:** Various Club members volunteered to support the various responsibilities of working at the fall rally such as moving the trailer, registration, getting prizes, trail route signage, etc.

New Business:

1. **Accident:** Following discussion, moved by Lloyd, "The persons recently involved in an ATV accident be invited to the meeting and inform the Club members of any safety trail issues should be addressed by the Club. That a get well card with enclosed gift certificate be forwarded to these individuals." Seconded by Jim. Carried
2. **Historical Cannon:** It was noted somewhere on the Skedaddle Trail network there exists an historical cannon dating back to the Civil War period. A community person knows approximately where this cannon is located. This person will be contacted and a report given at the next meeting.
4. **Club Rallies:** A discussion was held on the possibility of not organizing a Spring or Fall Rally. This topic will be discussed at a future Club meeting.
5. **Region Meeting:** Curtis and Allison will be the Club representatives at the Region 7 meeting, Woodstock 'Y', Thurs. Oct 5, 2017.
