**Minutes: November 2021**

The Nov. 25th meeting was held at the Mount Pleasant Community Center starting at 7:00 PM.

**Minutes:** The minutes of the August 2021 meeting were read. Moved by Stirling, seconded by Steve, "The minutes are approved as presented". Carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** Allison presented the financial report. Moved by Allison, seconded by Jeff, "The Treasurer's report is approved as presented." Carried.

**Old Business**

1. **Trail Maintenance:** Some trail work is required on the #25 trail close to the aircraft memorial and the Mountain view area. It was suggested Mike be contacted to address these two areas. Reference was made regarding brush cutting on trails. A suggested contractor was recommended. Due to high cost of culvert replacement in the Howard Brook area, it was suggested a new trail be considered to by-pass this section. Curtis will contact the land-owner for this possible route.
2. **Steel Stakes:** Cost for galvanized stakes, \$1.50 per foot. Protocols must be adhered for signage.
3. **Trail Maps:** There has been no reply from either DNRED or Quad NB on the Skedaddle trails that had undergone GPS mapping. During the interim, thirty current trail maps were printed.

**New Business:**

1. **Skedaddle 2022 Activity Dates:** Spring Rally June 4<sup>th</sup>, BBQ and Pot-Luck August 27<sup>th</sup>, Fall Rally Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>. Christmas Party Nov. 24<sup>th</sup>. All proposed dates may have to be adjusted due to Covid and NB Health protocols.
2. **Trail Permit Fees:** Quad NB will present proposed fee costs for a five year period to the membership at the Annual General Meeting. No date has been determined due to Covid.
3. **Regional Update:** It was referenced the Town of Nackawic wishes to provide additional support for ATV access within their community and will also provide support for a possible trail link across the St. John River using the Pokiok bridge. This must be approved by various government departments and might be in place by spring 2022 season. A possible NB-Maine ATV Trail Agreement has been proposed and is awaiting a decision from Maine. It is currently with the legislature in Augusta, Maine for consideration.
